

Lifeguard (part-time) The King's Club, Wimbledon

The King's Club is a private health club set in the grounds of King's College School, in the heart of Wimbledon village. The club has been in operation since 1994 and has recently undergone a major reconstruction boasting state of the art facilities which include: Indoor 25 metre 6 lane pool, gym and strength & conditioning rooms, exercise studio, floodlit tennis courts, squash courts and two sports halls.

The club is unique as it shares its facilities with King's College School and therefore opening hours are restricted to evenings and weekends. All profits from the King's Club support the school's bursary fund via Gift Aid. The bursary fund provides inspirational education to talented children, irrespective of background or means.

The Role:

To ensure the pool is operated in a safe and effective manner, particularly during swimming lessons and peak periods. To keep the pool area, including changing rooms, clean and tidy at all times.

Key Responsibilities:

- To ensure bather safety at all times
- To maintain order in the pool at all times
- To ensure pool rules and guidelines are adhered to at all times
- To ensure that all poolside areas are kept clean in line with health & safety guidelines
- To assist with pool water tests where required
- To keep the poolside cupboards tidy and clear of debris at all times
- To check the changing rooms regularly whilst on shift
- To report any maintenance issues to the Duty Manager at the earliest possible opportunity
- To be fully conversant with all emergency procedures for fire and accident and to report all incidents in the correct manner
- Attend training sessions and departmental meetings as and when required
- To be flexible when cover is needed
- Comply with the provisions of the company Health & Safety and Fire policies and implement where required
